Popcorn will be served on two Fridays each month, during the second nutrition break, in a fully sealed packaged bag that will be quarantined at the school prior to distribution. If Friday is a holiday, popcorn will be served on the Thursday prior, and if your child is absent on popcorn day, it will be held in the classroom for their return. Some of the popcorn days will coincide with the School Spirit days.

The cost per bag of popcorn is \$2.50 and funds raised will help pay for projects, programs, and experiences that Council funds. Please note that extra bags of popcorn will NOT be available on Popcorn/Spirit Days.
